

Payment for Tuition Fees (**Trimester system**) Third semester, Academic year 2017

Student checks a result of registration as requested and the amount of tuition fees for Third semester, Academic year 2017 at <http://www.reg.chula.ac.th> under the menu "Paying tuition fee" and pay tuition during

April 2 - 4, 2018. The following procedures should be undertaken:

1 New Students entering in Second semester (ID. 60x xxxxx xx)

Students should print a CR8 form under the menu Paying tuition fee and take CR8 form to pay tuition at any branch of Siam Commercial Bank (SCB Bank).

2 All Current Students (ID. 55x xxxxx xx – 60x xxxxx xx)

2.1 Students who pay by the automatically transfer system, deposit tuition fees to each individual's bank account number. Please be sure that sufficient amount of money to pay the fees is in the account. The bank's system will automatically transfer the amount of tuition fees from the student's account to the university's account.

2.2 Students who pay by CR8 form, print a CR8 form under the menu "Paying tuition fee" and take a CR8 form to pay tuition at any branch of Siam Commercial Bank (SCB bank).

2.3 Students can change a method of payment from automatically transfer system to pay by CR8 form, login to the menu "Paying tuition fee" and click for changing at the bottom of the screen and confirm. Then print CR8 and take a CR8 form to pay tuition at any branch of Siam Commercial Bank (SCB bank).

2.4 If students would like to make payment by deducting the tuition fees from their accounts again, they have to submit a request (CR41) at the Office of the Registrar for next semester.

3 Students can then **check the completed payment and print a receipt start on April 6, 2018.**

4 In the case that a student is unable to pay for tuition fees by the time indicated, course registration will be cancelled.

5 If student's CR74 shown all courses not registered, student should also pay for tuition fees by the time indicated. Otherwise student needs to register late during two weeks of semester and pay tuition plus fine fees.
