

Announcement on Tuition Fees Payment (Trimester System) Second Semester, Academic Year 2018

1. Students who have requested for course registration in the 2nd Semester, 2018 (first round) **Payment via CU NEX Mobile Application** during November 28 – December 5, 2018
2. Students who are taking leave in the semester can pay student status maintaining fees through CU NEX Mobile Application by choosing “Status Maintaining” under “Payment” menu and submit Request Form for Leave of Absence (CR49) at the faculty’s registrar office.
3. Graduate students who are only registering for Comprehensive Examination or Qualifying Examination (COO) courses in the semester should pay 5,000 baht of status maintaining fees through CU NEX Application by choosing “Registering for COQ Courses” under “Payment” menu.
4. Students will be able to receive the tuition fees payment receipt through e-mail address as labeled in the student profile. For new students will be able to receive the tuition fees payment receipt through students’ e-mail (....@student.chula.ac.th) from December 12, 2018.
5. Students who have requested for course registration in the first round but have not paid the tuition fees will have their course registration result cancelled.
6. Students who are not able to register for any course (as shown in CR74) are still obliged to pay the tuition fees within the period stated above.
7. According to the University’s announcement, students who have not paid the tuition fees within the period are subject to pay late registration fees in addition to the tuition fees within the first two weeks of the semester:
 - 7.1 Payment period for first week: December 11 – 16, 2018 (with 300 baht late registration fees)
 - 7.2 Payment period for second week: December 18 – 23, 2018 (with 600 baht late registration fees)
